UNIVERSITY TO REQUEST FOR THE CONVERSION OF THE POST OFFICE TO BE THE NEW USSC
OFFICE

WHEREAS, the University Supreme Student Council is the highest governing body of the students in the University and being embodied by the CSSC's as per *2011 USSC Constitution and By-laws Article III section 1*.

WHEREAS, the USSC, in view of its function is vested with the Executive and Legislative powers (2011 USSC Constitution and By-laws Article VII Section 1) in order to fully implement its policies for the betterment of the students, protection of the rights and the promotion of the interests of our sector.
